Range Safety Rules

CARDINAL RULES:

- 1. Treatall weapons as if they are loaded.
- 2. Never point a firearm at anyone unless you are justified in using the weapon.
- 3. Know your target and beyond.

SPECIFIC RULES:

- DO NOT HORSEPLAY or behave carelessly. It will not be tolerated during training.
- Upon picking up a firearm, immediately point the weapon down range, open the slide or cylinder and ensure the weapon is unloaded and safe.
- Never give or receive a firearm unless the slide/cylinder is open.
- NEVER ANTICIPATE A COMMAND.
- Before loading your firearm, make sure it is free of obstructions (bullet/dirt).
- Load only after position is taken at the firing line and the command to load is given by the instructor.
- Point your weapon down range when loading or unloading and when using a clearing barrel.
- NEVER draw or re-holster your weapon with your finger in the trigger guard. If your weapon is so equipped, De-Cock your weapon after each string of fire before you holster it.
- THERE IS NO TALKING ON THE FIRING LINE or to shooters on the line except by an instructor.
- Never permit the muzzle of a firearm to touch the ground.
- Training is conducted on a HOT RANGE. If you have a misfire, remember your training and clear the weapon (Tap Rack). If you need an instructor, keep your weapon pointed down range, stay in position, and raise your non-weapon hand for assistance.
- Never walk in front of the firing line until an INSTRUCTOR has cleared the range and instructs you to do so.
- ALL shooters will wear eye and ear protection when the range is HOT (on the line and behind it)
- Load your duty weapon magazines before you leave the training area. Proceed to the designated loading area or clearing barrel, and charge your weapon with issued duty ammunition only.
